

Walking blameless in the Face of YHWH

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Over the course of the past several weeks we have been examining the issue of Zionism.

The recent dramatic events occurring in Israel have brought to the forefront the question of the Covenant Land, and who has the right to live there.

It is a highly charged and polarizing issue. People are often tempted to take sides, but there are not always just two sides. Sometimes taking any side is foolish and destructive if it is not the side of YHWH.

Right now, many people are either Standing with Israel or Standing with the Palestinians.

The thing is that you can be outraged and disgusted by the attacks from Hamas and also be disturbed and reviled by the Israeli response. They are not mutually exclusive.

You don't necessarily have to be on one side or the other.

Americans have been conditioned into taking sides through sports, politics and even moral issues. Their political parties are even

categorized as right or left. So they have a tendency to take a position, pick a team and view others as their opponents.

Life in America, and the world, has become extremely adversarial and divisive. I see it every day.

Prosecutors going after alleged criminals. Neighbors suing neighbors. Spouses suing one another for divorce and fighting over their children.

If families are falling apart, how can communities and a nation come together? The outlook is pretty grim in America.

As America has aligned with Israel in this recent conflict, they are both deeply divided, and almost evenly split between the right and the left.

This is all very consistent with the way westerners think, which is linear. On the other hand, anyone who thinks like a Hebrew finds it easy to step out of that right vs. left paradigm.

Hebrew thought is similar to eastern thought, which is cyclical. It is not confined to binary limitations.

A Hebrew can therefore disagree with Israel and political Zionism without being anti-Semitic. A Hebrew can sympathize with the civilians in Gaza without being pro-Palestinian or a Hamas supporter. A true Hebrew sheds the scales of flesh from their eyes and views things with circumcised hearts.

My focus over the past month has been to warn followers of Yahushua regarding their response to the current conflict.

There is a script that is being played out on the world scene and we need to think and act like Hebrews connected to YHWH most High, not like a bunch of Babylonians connected to CNN and Fox News.

Sadly, many have been steeped in Christian Zionism, without ever even realizing it. Therefore, it is important to recognize that fact and sever its influence from our thoughts, beliefs and actions.

If you have an automatic response to stand with the modern State of Israel and support Israel no matter what they say or do, then you probably have been influenced by Christian Zionism to some degree.

I recently saw a post that said: "If you have a problem with Israel, then your problem is not with Israel but your problem is with the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob."

That's a pretty absurd and ignorant statement to make. What's even worse is that it came from an alleged Messianic Teacher. It doesn't appear that the individual has the slightest amount of spiritual discernment.

So are we to understand that the modern State of Israel is above reproach and can do no wrong? They are untouchable because they are doing the will of YHWH at all times? Or YHWH simply overlooks everything Israel does simply because they are the chosen people?

That type of statement is symptomatic of extremely bad doctrine deriving from Christian Zionism.

Last week I talked about some of the factors that resulted in the creation of Christian Zionism. One of them included the doctrine of Dispensationalism, which was built upon the older belief in "Restorationism."

While the set apart assembly of YHWH will be restored to the Covenant Land, that Assembly will only include those in a Covenant relationship with Elohim.

If you are a follower of the Messiah, then you should understand that He renewed the Covenant with Yisrael, and He is the Covenant.

So any restoration of a Covenant promise must find it's fulfillment through the Messiah, not Christian Zionists funneling money, guns and bombs to a group of Jewish people calling themselves Israel.

No doubt, this is a highly emotional issue with a wide range of opinions because most Christians have not been taught the enormity of what Yahushua did in the past, and what He will do in the future.

Most of them also completely fail to understand that the Covenant He renewed was with Yisrael. The twelve disciples at the Passover meal called The Last Supper represented Yisrael. Only one of the disciples named Judas (Yahuda) left after the Passover meal. (see John 13:26-29)

That is a highly significant detail to point out, because it was after he left that Yahushua stated: *"I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me."* John 14:6

He also stated: *"¹⁵ If you love Me, keep My Commandments. ¹⁶ And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may abide with you forever - ¹⁷ the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him; but you know Him, for He dwells with you and will be in you. ¹⁸ I will not leave you orphans; I will come to you."* John 14:15-18

Now this is important when you consider the distinction made in the promise concerning the new and renewed Covenant provided

through Jeremiah. *“But this is the Covenant that I will make with the et-house of Yisrael after those days, says YHWH: I will put My et-Torah in their minds, and write it on their hearts; and I will be their Elohim, and they shall be My people.”* Jeremiah 31:33

There is a reason why the promise focuses specifically on the et-house of Yisrael. They will have circumcised hearts through the Set Apart Spirit. They won't need to dance around with Torah Scrolls. They will have the et-Torah in their minds and on their hearts thanks to the Messiah. The Aleph Taw (et) obviously represents Yahushua the Messiah.

Sadly, Christians mostly fail to understand their destiny through the Covenant renewed by the Messiah of Yisrael. They are supposed to be filled with the Spirit so that can obey the Torah and follow Yahushua.

They don't recognize that the renewed Covenant brings them into Yisrael. Yisrael is a covenant Kingdom ruled by YHWH and His Son, the Prince of Peace. In the future, Yahushua, the Son of Adam, will assume the throne as King of the kingdom that Adam lost. He will do this at the same time that He restores Yisrael.

With the recent conflict in Israel and Gaza I am trying to emphasize the deeper Scriptural truths involved here, because all of the superficial issues completely ignore the significance of Yahushua and the Covenant that He renewed through His broken body and shed blood.

Those who follow Judaism seek to blot out the Name and memory of Yahushua, who they denigrate as Y.E.S.U., which stands for “may His Name and Memory be blotted out.” They want a restoration without Yahushua, and many even want it without YHWH.

I place particular blame on Christian Zionists who are supposed to be shining the light of truth concerning the Messiah. Instead, they confuse the Scriptural Tzyon with Zionist Jews. They simply go along to get along. They don't feel any need to bring up Yahushua, because that would wreck the relationship they have with "Brother Judah." They don't seem to have any problem not mentioning their Messiah Yahushua, since the Jews are so offended by Him.

I remember talking to a Jewish woman at the Yisrael Connection in Panama many years ago. She was worried that we were going to use "the J word." I said "You mean Joshua?"

I was pointing out how screwed up the Christian and Jewish understanding has gotten. She was worried I was going to say Jesus, and His Name is Yahushua – the same name as the Patriarch that many call Joshua.

I recently heard Yael Eckstein state that the name Jesus was "a trigger" for her. Nevertheless, she is more than willing to go to churches and endure the pain as long as the Christian Zionists give her checks for the IFCJ.

Ultimately, this discussion boils down to the fact that "the Promised Land" is YHWH's Land.

Consider some passages concerning the Commandment of the Jubilee.

"¹⁷ Therefore you shall not oppress one another, but you shall fear your Elohim; for I am YHWH your Elohim. ¹⁸ So you shall observe My statutes and keep My judgments, and perform them; and you will dwell in the land in safety. ¹⁹ Then the land will yield its fruit, and you will eat your fill, and dwell there in safety. ²⁰ And if you say, 'What shall we eat in the seventh year, since we shall not sow nor gather in our produce?' ²¹ Then

I will command My blessing on you in the sixth year, and it will bring forth produce enough for three years.²² And you shall sow in the eighth year, and eat old produce until the ninth year; until its produce comes in, you shall eat of the old harvest.²³ The land shall not be sold permanently, for the land is Mine; for you are strangers and sojourners with Me.²⁴ And in all the land of your possession you shall grant redemption of the land . . .⁵⁵ For the children of Yisrael are servants to Me; they are My servants whom I brought out of the land of Egypt: I am YHWH your Elohim.” Leviticus 25:17-24, 55

The Jubilee was all about getting back your portion of the Land. It belonged to YHWH. He was the Landlord, and the Yisraelites were the Tenants. They could dwell safely in the Land if they were obedient to the terms of the Lease provided through the Covenant. YHWH would protect the Tenants if they honored the Lease.

If they broke the Lease (Covenant), that was cause for an eviction proceeding.

Unfortunately, I see a lot of evictions in my practice. People break their leases all the time. They refuse to pay their rent, they wreck their dwellings and the Landlord eventually has to get them out before they completely destroy the place.

Interestingly, during COVID thousands of tenants decided not to abide by the lease and refused to pay rent while the United States government actually sided with the squatters. This resulted in tremendous losses to Landlords as the United States government simply disregarded contractual rights of landowners and prohibited them from evicting tenants. Of course, that was completely unconstitutional as the Courts later decided, but the damage was already done.

That's not much different than what we see going on in Israel. YHWH, as the Landlord, had a lease agreement with His people Yisrael. They needed to abide by the terms and pay Him rent (firstfruits) in order to dwell in the Land. He brought them out of slavery so they could serve Him in His Land. If they refused to live according to the agreement, then they would be evicted, and that's exactly what happened.

What we see happening now is like the great, great, great, great . . . grandchildren of former tenants coming back claiming a right to live there without the Lease Agreement (Covenant). It's not a valid legal claim. They need a new lease with the Landlord. Instead, the Zionists simply moved in and forced out the other people living there. In many cases, they actually stole the houses of those other people. Not only did they force their way back in, but they haven't been paying rent. They are claiming to be Israel, but they are not acting like Yisrael. They are squatters in the eyes of YHWH.

No one has a right to move in and claim Covenant rights to the Land unless YHWH permits them to return and unless they are actually in a Covenant relationship with Him. That concept is referred to as "privity of contract" in common law. In other words, you need to be a legitimate party to a contract before you can claim rights under a contract.

Holding a piece of paper that says you are Jewish or having an Israeli ID card does not equate to being in Covenant with Elohim. It doesn't give them privity of contract.

As I said, most Christian Zionists fail to understand the Covenant promises, because they have been taught incorrectly by their various denominations. Most Christian Churches teach that all of that stuff in "the Old Testament" is exactly that - old.

They believe that while it may still apply to physical Jews, it does not apply to the Christian Church. Therefore, the Jews can have the Land, because Christians are going to heaven.

That describes the effects of Dispensationalism in a nut shell.

Christian Zionists then take it to the next level. Since they believe that the Jewish people represent the ancient Yisraelites, then the Jewish people are entitled to the Land - all of it. Regardless of whether there were people already living there. The simple fact that they identify themselves as Jews and take on the label of Israel is all that matters to Christian Zionists.

Again, they ignore the terms of the Covenant, the reasons why YHWH evicted them in the past, and why Yahushua the Messiah called down judgment upon them.

Apparently, none of that matters anymore to Christian Zionists since they think that Jesus abolished the Torah.

So, enough time has passed. Let's just let bygones be bygones. All is forgotten and forgiven and they have a green light to return. Right?

Well, we don't have any prophets to tell us that the Yahudim or a group of Jewish people can return after rejecting the Messiah and then being ejected from the Land.

Nor can Christian Zionists explain how the Jewish people can claim any rights outside of a broken Covenant without a new or renewed Covenant.

There is no Scriptural basis for supporting or standing with the modern State of Israel. In fact, those Christians who "stand with

Israel” instead of “standing as Yisrael” are like Esau selling their birthright for a bowl of stew.

Remember how Esau gave his firstborn privileges away at a meal? Yahushua, the firstborn Son of Elohim, gave us all the right to enter the Kingdom as firstborn (firstfruits) at a Covenant meal – the Passover.

During the Passover He took the bread and broke it and stated: *“This is My body which is given for you; do this in remembrance of Me.”* Luke 22:19 He also took the cup after supper, saying, *“This cup is the new covenant in My blood, which is shed for you.”* Luke 22:20

How many Christian Zionists actually obey Yahushua? How many commemorate the renewed Covenant at Passover with the understanding that they are in the Covenant as Yisrael? I suspect very few.

Of course, that explains the mystery of the 144,000, which is a “perfect” number concerning the Tribes of Yisrael. The Bride is the City of Tzyon, the New Jerusalem. She is truly a small remnant of the over 2.38 billion people who identify as Christians in the world.

Christians should be claiming the promises of Tzyon instead of relegating those promises to Zionists. They are literally giving up their birthright. If you are willing to give away your birthright so easily, then you don’t deserve it. In fact, it places you on bad terms with YHWH when you reject His gift. Consider how He looks upon Esau for despising his birthright. (see Malachi 1:2-3)

Isaiah proclaimed ³ *Let not the foreigner who has joined himself to YHWH say: YHWH will surely separate me from His people and let not the eunuch say, Behold, I am a dry tree.* ⁴ *For thus says YHWH: To the eunuchs who keep My Sabbaths, who choose the things that please me*

and hold fast My covenant, ⁵ I will give in My house and within My walls a monument and a name better than sons and daughters; I will give them an everlasting name that shall not be cut off. ⁶ And the foreigners who join themselves to YHWH, to minister to Him, to love the name of YHWH, and to be His servants, everyone who keeps the Sabbath and does not profane it, and holds fast My covenant - ⁷ these I will bring to My holy mountain, and make them joyful in My house of prayer; their burnt offerings and their sacrifices will be accepted on My altar; for My house shall be called a House of Prayer for all Nations. ⁸ YHWH Elohim, who gathers the outcasts of Yisrael, declares, I will gather yet others to him besides those already gathered.” Isaiah 56:3-8

This was a hallmark prophecy involving the Messiah. Do you remember that He would quote this verse whenever He cleansed the Temple? (see Matthew 21:13, Mark 11:17 and Luke 19:46)

It was supposed to be a House of Prayer for ALL Nations, but the Yahudim had put up a fence around the Torah, and a wall around the Temple prohibiting entry by foreigners.

Yahushua made a way for the strangers and the foreigners. It doesn't matter if you are Jewish or from any other lineage. You can partake in the Covenant, but you must take hold of the tzitzit of Yahushua and not let go.

It's your choice.

You can “take hold” of the covenant promises of Yisrael, or be deceived into relinquishing them to those disguised as Israel.

Well, this is outside of most people's prophetic paradigm. They have been fed a binary understanding of the Scriptures, and this is likely entirely out of bounds for them.

In fact, over the past week I have been performing “prophetic triage” with some Christian Zionists who twist Scriptures that result in heretical doctrines.

The problem is that Christian Zionist ideologies simply don’t hold up when put to the test. Once you start to point out their errors and their prophetic paradigm collapses, they begin to hemorrhage. They get angry, cast aspersions and throw tantrums as they go into Hypovolemic shock.

Last week, I examined how the promise to Abram in Genesis 12 has been completely misappropriated by the Jewish people and Christian Zionists.

I thought that it would be helpful to follow that Covenant promise as it continued through Abraham and Sarah, specifically to Isaac.

After the promise of “seed” in Genesis 12, Abram had travelled to Egypt and returned with Hagar. She was an Egyptian, and some believe that her name was actually Keturah, who Abraham later had children with after the death of Sarah.

The name Hagar is literally “ha’ger” in Hebrew. It means “the stranger.” So, Abram had a son with “the stranger” and the child was named Yishmael.

Now it is important to recognize that Yishma’el was named by the Messenger of YHWH. There is no denying the similarity between Yisra’el and Yishma’el.

The Hebrew name Yishma’el means “El hears.” It literally contains “shema” at the heart of the name, and there is a powerful emphasis on “hearing.”

After the child was born we read: *“And as for Yishma’el, I have heard you. Behold, I have blessed him, and will make him fruitful, and will multiply him exceedingly. He shall beget twelve princes, and I will make him a great nation.”* Genesis 17:20

It is no coincidence that Yishma’el would also have twelve tribes. That is an entirely different conversation, but it is important to point out that while Yishma’el would be blessed, he was not the seed that would inherit the Covenant promise.

Here is how we know that:

“¹ When Abram was ninety-nine years old YHWH appeared to Abram and said to him, I am El Shaddai; walk before Me, and be blameless, ² that I may make My covenant between me and you, and may multiply you greatly. ³ Then Abram fell on his face. And Elohim said to him, ⁴ Behold, My Covenant is with you, and you shall be the father of a multitude of Nations. ⁵ No longer shall your name be called Abram, but your name shall be Abraham, for I have made you the father of a multitude of Nations. ⁶ I will make you exceedingly fruitful, and I will make you into Nations, and kings shall come from you. ⁷ And I will establish My covenant between Me and you and your seed after you throughout their generations for an everlasting covenant, to be Elohim to you and to your seed after you. ⁸ And I will give to you and to your seed after you the land of your sojournings, all the land of Canaan, for an everlasting possession, and I will be their Elohim.” Genesis 17:1-8

Walk before me and be blameless! This is critical to understand.

The phrase “walk before me” literally means “walk in My face.” In other words, walk in the sight of YHWH and be “blameless.” The Hebrew word translated as “blameless” is “tamiym.”

It is the same word used to describe how Noah walked with Elohim.

“Noah was a just man, perfect (tamiym) in his generations. Noah walked with Elohim.” Genesis 6:9

Job was also described as being “tamiym.”

“There was a man in the land of Uz whose name was Job, and that man was tamiym and upright, one who feared Elohim and turned away from evil.” Job 1:1

Tamiym can mean “blameless, perfect or without defect.” For instance, the red heifer sacrifice was specifically commanded to be “tamiym.” (Numbers 19:12)

Consider the first verse in the longest Psalm in the Scriptures. *“Blessed are those whose way is blameless (tamiym), who walk in Torah of YHWH.”* Psalm 119:1

This is a bedrock principle of the Scriptures. Walking in the ways of the Torah classifies you as blameless.

I doesn't mean that you are perfect, but that you are walking in the perfect way. We are considered “tamiym” when we fear Elohim and follow the instructions.

Ultimately, our walk and the way we live is compared to the sacrifice that we would sacrifice on the altar to YHWH. That was the purpose of the sacrificial system. Just as the people were supposed to give their best to YHWH, we are supposed to live our best for YHWH.

It is important to understand that YHWH is the One Who prescribes the requisite conduct. So, it's not anything that comes from us that makes us blameless. It is simply following Him as we walk through

this life, He leads us on the perfect path, and we follow in His footsteps.

Just so there was no question about how to walk, YHWH sent His Son as the Torah in the flesh to literally walk the “perfect” (tamiym) covenant path and then shed His blood to wash is clean so that we can be without defect.

All we need to do is “follow Him.” Make no mistake. It is still a walk.

So, the way we walk is a critical part of being in a Covenant relationship with YHWH. If you walk according to the terms of the Covenant then you are in the Covenant relationship. YHWH is your Elohim, and you are part of His people.

With that foundational understanding we can then continue to see how YHWH “renews” the Covenant with Abram. We saw that his name was changed to Abraham. YHWH confirmed that they were in a Covenant relationship, and the Covenant specifically focused on Nations.

In fact, three times the promise of Nations was provided. The emphasis on Nations is then followed by the promise of “seed” three times. So there is a clear correlation between the “seed” of Abraham and the “Nations.”

Just as we previously discussed the “seed” (zera) in Genesis 12, YHWH was again emphasizing a specific seed.

The promise would not flow through the other sons of Abraham, This was not made to the Jewish people, and there was no such thing as Yisrael, the Christian Religion, Judaism or the modern State of Israel at this point.

The promise was made to pass through the “seed” Isaac who was born from Sarah. He was her only begotten son.

Isaac and Rebekah went on to have twin brothers - Esau and Jacob. We have discussed previously how Esau traded his birthright for a meal, but that wasn't enough. Jacob then disguised himself as Esau and lied to his father. It showed how strongly Jacob wanted the birthright.

Well, he got what he wanted. The promise of “seed” ultimately passed to Jacob.

Here is the blessing provided by his father Isaac: *“³ May El Shaddai bless you, and make you fruitful and multiply you, that you may be an assembly (qahal) of peoples; ⁴ And give you the blessing of Abraham, To you and your seed with you, that you may inherit the land in which you are a stranger, which Elohim gave to Abraham.”* Genesis 28:3-4

I detail the flow of the Covenant in the Walk in the Light series book called [Covenants](#). We don't have the space to do it here. Ultimately, the promise of seed continued to pass through the Covenant up to David

Here is the promise to David: *“¹² When your days are fulfilled and you lie down with your fathers, I will raise up your et-seed after you, who shall come from your body, and I will establish his kingdom. ¹³ He shall build a house for My Name, and I will establish the throne of his kingdom forever. ¹⁴ I will be to him a father, and he shall be to me a son. When he commits iniquity, I will discipline him with the rod of men, with the stripes of the sons of men, ¹⁵ but My steadfast love will not depart from him, as I took it from Saul, whom I put away from before you. ¹⁶ And your house and your kingdom shall be made sure forever before me. Your throne shall be established forever.”* 2 Samuel 7:12-16

David was the shepherd King who united both Houses of Yisrael and Yahudah into the Kingdom of Yisrael. The promise of seed was to a particular seed – the Aleph Taw (et). This was a Messianic reference, and it was not referring to his descendant Solomon, who was responsible for the Kingdom being divided.

You see, Solomon was wise, but he was not blameless. He was given the great honor of building the House of YHWH, but he ended up participating in the worst of sins. (1 Kings 11:1-11)

In fact, tradition holds that the Star of Saturn that the modern state of currently Israel uses as its national emblem was part of the Seal of Solomon that he used to summon and commission demons.

It is amazing how all you have to do is repackage and rename something in order for people to be completely deceived. How many people are waving Israeli flags and donning the Star of Saturn because people call it “the Star of David” or “the Shield of David”?

The hexagram was used in withcraft. You have heard the phrase about placing “a hex” upon someone. The powers behind the modern State of Israel have literally placed a spell upon people, and only those with spiritual discernment can see the deception.

Just because they call themselves Israel does not mean that they are actually the Covenant assembly (qahal) of Yisrael.

Remember that when Jacob dressed up in Esau’s clothing and presented himself to his father as Esau, he was not truly Esau. Jacob “disguised” himself as Esau in order to get the blessings of the firstborn. That is exactly the same tactic being used by Israel today. We are currently seeing “the Jewish people” disguise themselves as Yisrael in order to lay claim to the promise of the Land.

We can easily discern this because they are not walking “blameless” in the face of YHWH. They may carry the label, but that’s about it. They are not doing the priestly service of Yisrael outwardly, and they are not Yisrael inwardly. They do not have circumcised hearts, and they are not following the instructions of YHWH.

Thankfully, those with eyes to see through the deception understand that the Covenant promise regarding the “et-seed” of David was fulfilled through Yahushua. Sadly, none of the Christian Zionists seem to have the requisite discernment.

The promises are in their Scriptures, so they have no excuse. Here are the words spoken to Miryam by the Messenger Gabriel:

“³⁰ . . . Do not be afraid, Miryam, for you have found favor with Elohim. ³¹ And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bear a Son, and you shall call His name Yahushua. ³² He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High. And YHWH Elohim will give to Him the throne of His father David, ³³ and he will reign over the House of Jacob forever, and of His kingdom there will be no end.” Luke 1:30-33

There it is. The promises given to the et-seed of David are fulfilled through Yahushua. This is true “Christian Zionism,” or should I say “Tzyonism.” The focus is on Yahushua ruling over the Kingdom, not the Jewish people and the modern State of Israel.

Yahushua was the promised seed, as could clearly be seen through the “sign in the heavens” that appeared in the sky over Jerusalem when He was born.

That sign was described in Revelation 12:1-2 as follows:

“¹ And a great sign appeared in heaven: a woman clothed with the sun, with the moon under her feet, and on her head a crown of twelve stars.

² She was pregnant and was crying out in birth pains and the agony of giving birth."

We know when that sign occurred. It was Yom Teruah on the Gregorian date of September 11, 3 BCE.

That was when we saw the constellation Bethulah (the virgin) clothed by the setting sun with the moon at her feet. The brightest star in Bethulah a called "tzemach" in Hebrew, which means "the branch." In Latin the star is called "Spica" which literally means "a kernel of wheat" – a seed.

Could this be why Yahushua said: *"²³ The hour has come that the Son of Man should be glorified. ²⁴ Most assuredly, I say to you, unless a grain of wheat falls into the ground and dies, it remains alone; but if it dies, it produces much grain. ²⁵ He who loves his life will lose it, and he who hates his life in this world will keep it for eternal life. ²⁶ If anyone serves Me, let him follow Me; and where I am, there My servant will be also. If anyone serves Me, him My Father will honor."* John 12:23-26

The point is to show the emphasis on the seed that actually occurred in the heavens at the moment that the Promised Seed entered into this world.

Therefore, all of the amazing prophecies of a restoration through David are fulfilled through Yahushua, not Zionism. Christian Zionists are not serving Yahushua by serving and supporting Zionism. They are actually supporting the New World Order in its quest to divide, distract, annihilate and destroy mankind.

The modern State of Israel is a false restoration and a distraction that is supported, promoted and funded by the New World Order.

I wrote about that many years ago in my book titled [The Redeemed](#). I have felt compelled to address this in my recent messages based upon the appalling actions that I am witnessing from people who claim to follow Yahushua.

Again, this is all about the eternal King promised to come from David. That message has been lost and confused due to all of the false shepherds out there.

Here is a description of the return and restoration of the House of Yisrael described by Ezekiel through the promised Shepherd King.

“¹ And the word of YHWH came to me, saying, ² Son of man, prophesy against the shepherds of Yisrael, prophesy and say to them, Thus says Adonai YHWH to the shepherds: Woe to the shepherds of Yisrael who feed themselves! Should not the shepherds feed the flocks? ³ You eat the fat and clothe yourselves with the wool; you slaughter the fatlings, but you do not feed the flock. ⁴ The weak you have not strengthened, nor have you healed those who were sick, nor bound up the broken, nor brought back what was driven away, nor sought what was lost; but with force and cruelty you have ruled them. ⁵ So they were scattered because there was no shepherd; and they became food for all the beasts of the field when they were scattered. ⁶ My sheep wandered through all the mountains, and on every high hill; yes, My flock was scattered over the whole face of the earth, and no one was seeking or searching for them. ⁷ Therefore, you shepherds, hear the word of YHWH: ⁸ As I live, says Adonai YHWH, surely because My flock became a prey, and My flock became food for every beast of the field, because there was no shepherd, nor did My shepherds search for My flock, but the shepherds fed themselves and did not feed My flock - ⁹ therefore, O shepherds, hear the word of YHWH! ¹⁰ Thus says Adonai

YHWH: Behold, I am against the shepherds, and I will require My flock at their hand; I will cause them to cease feeding the sheep, and the shepherds shall feed themselves no more; for I will deliver My flock from their mouths, that they may no longer be food for them. ¹¹ For thus says Adonai YHWH: Indeed I Myself will search for My sheep and seek them out. ¹² As a shepherd seeks out his flock on the day he is among his scattered sheep, so will I seek out My sheep and deliver them from all the places where they were scattered on a cloudy and dark day. ¹³ And I will bring them out from the peoples and gather them from the countries, and will bring them to their own land; I will feed them on the mountains of Yisrael, in the valleys and in all the inhabited places of the country. ¹⁴ I will feed them in good pasture, and their fold shall be on the high mountains of Yisrael. There they shall lie down in a good fold and feed in rich pasture on the mountains of Yisrael. ¹⁵ I will feed My flock, and I will make them lie down, says Adonai YHWH. ¹⁶ I will seek what was lost and bring back what was driven away, bind up the broken and strengthen what was sick; but I will destroy the fat and the strong, and feed them in judgment. ¹⁷ And as for you, O My flock, thus says Adonai YHWH: Behold, I shall judge between sheep and sheep, between rams and goats. ¹⁸ Is it too little for you to have eaten up the good pasture, that you must tread down with your feet the residue of your pasture - and to have drunk of the clear waters, that you must foul the residue with your feet? ¹⁹ And as for My flock, they eat what you have trampled with your feet, and they drink what you have fouled with your feet. ²⁰ Therefore thus says Adonai YHWH to them: Behold, I Myself will judge between the fat and the lean sheep. ²¹ Because you have pushed with side and shoulder, butted all the weak ones with your horns, and scattered them abroad, ²² therefore I will save My flock, and they shall no longer be a prey; and I will judge between sheep and sheep. ²³ I will establish One Shepherd over them, and He shall feed them - My servant David. He shall feed them and be their Shepherd. ²⁴ And I, YHWH, will be their Elohim, and My servant David a prince among them; I, YHWH, have spoken. ²⁵ I will make a Covenant of Shalom with them, and cause wild beasts to cease from the land; and they will dwell

safely in the wilderness and sleep in the woods. ²⁶ I will make them and the places all around My hill a blessing; and I will cause showers to come down in their season; there shall be showers of blessing. ²⁷ Then the trees of the field shall yield their fruit, and the earth shall yield her increase. They shall be safe in their land; and they shall know that I am YHWH, when I have broken the bands of their yoke and delivered them from the hand of those who enslaved them. ²⁸ And they shall no longer be a prey for the Nations, nor shall beasts of the land devour them; but they shall dwell safely, and no one shall make them afraid. ²⁹ I will raise up for them a garden^[d] of renown, and they shall no longer be consumed with hunger in the land, nor bear the shame of the Nations anymore. ³⁰ Thus they shall know that I, YHWH their Elohim, am with them, and they, the house of Yisrael, are My people, says Adonai YHWH. ³¹ You are My flock, the flock of My pasture; you are men, and I am your Elohim, says Adonai YHWH.”
Ezekiel 34:

Yahushua is “My Servant David” referred to throughout the prophets. Yahushua, the Prince of Shalom, will make a Covenant of Shalom when He finally restores this planet. Shalom can mean peace, but it also carries a sense of completion and fulfillment.

He is the One who will judge Jacob, rebuild the “Tabernacle of David” and restore the Kingdom by drawing the House of Yisrael back from the Nations.

“⁸ Behold, the eyes of Adonai YHWH are on the sinful kingdom, and I will destroy it from the face of the earth; Yet I will not utterly destroy the house of Jacob, Says YHWH. ⁹ For surely I will command, and will sift the house of Yisrael among all nations, As grain is sifted in a sieve; Yet not the smallest grain shall fall to the ground. ¹⁰ All the sinners of My people shall die by the sword, Who say, The calamity shall not overtake nor confront us. ¹¹ On that day I will raise up the et-sukka of David, which has fallen down, and repair its damages; I will raise up its ruins,

and rebuild it as in the days of old; ¹² That they may possess the remnant of Edom, and all the Nations who are called by My Name, Says YHWH who does this thing.” Amos 9:8-12

The House of Yisrael are not the Jewish people. They are the ones from the Northern Tribes who were scattered into the Nations. They are the lost sheep that Yahushua came to seek out. They are the sheep who hear the Shepherds voice and respond to His call. And the key is to be called by the Name of YHWH, not to call yourself Israel.

The prophets are filled with descriptions of the restoration that will occur when Messiah returns.

Instead of proclaiming this truth and waiting for the King to return and restore justice, we see a bunch of bloodthirsty Christian Zionists standing with Israel and calling for the annihilation of Hamas and the Palestinians. I'm fairly certain that these deceived individuals will be among those who will be weeping and gnashing their teeth when they are told by Yahushua that He does not know them.

Let's get one thing straight. YHWH hated the fact that Esau despised his birthright and that the Edomites, at times, opposed the Yisraelites. He even judged them for their actions. That does not mean that YHWH hates all of the Arabs and Muslims.

He wants them to be drawn out of their deception and brought back to Him. He wants the same for the Christian Zionists and the Jewish people. He will gather a people from ALL the Nations. That's what His Prophets repeatedly state and this is the truth that we must proclaim.

In fact, that is supposed to be the role of Yisrael. Instead, we see Zionist Jews and Zionist Christians ready to wage a holy war and annihilate their perceived enemies.

In a recent resolution before the Florida state legislature, Representative Nixon proposed a ceasefire resolution. In her speech in support of the resolution she said: “We are at 10,000 dead Palestinians. How many will be enough?”

Representative Michelle Salzman immediately called out “All of them.” She later stated that she only meant Hamas, but the fact is “words can kill” as a friend of mine has notably stated.

These words being spewed by adherents of Zionism are so far removed from the Scriptural role of Yisrael, and this is what happens when you twist the Scriptures and disconnect from the True Vine. (John 15) We need to be speaking words of life and pointing people to the source of Life.

The Scriptures provide the path to life and the legal requirements for the restoration of Yisrael. Only the Promised Seed, the righteous Branch of David, has a right to bring together the tribes and unite the divided Kingdom of Yisrael.

I often speak about the “legalities” of things, because YHWH is all about statutes, ordinances, judgments, commandments and precision.

That is why we observe a physical universe with laws built into the fabric of Creation. They are called “the Laws of Physics,” but they should really be called the Laws of the Creator.

YHWH built laws into His Universe, including the Laws of blessings and curses. He has had rules for dwelling in His Land since the beginning. That is exactly what we read about in the Garden of Eden. It is because Adam broke those Laws that mankind was expelled from paradise and is under a curse of death. It is only through the Laws of YHWH that mankind will be redeemed and restored.

His Covenant is a legal agreement with terms and conditions that are part of that divine legal system.

As a lawyer of over 32 years I have studied, negotiated and written more contracts than I can count. A contract is an agreement between parties that establishes a relationship that is defined by the terms and conditions. If you are going to enter into a contract, you had better know the terms.

I spent my youth in the Christian religion being told about a New Covenant that defines a relationship between YHWH and His people. Sadly, no one ever told me the “terms” of that Covenant.

I was simply told that I needed to “believe in Jesus,” “ask Jesus into my heart,” “accept” and “receive” Jesus. I was never really told that I was entering into a Covenant relationship that had terms and conditions.

When I started examining the Covenant, all of the errors that I inherited from my fathers became clear. (see Jeremiah 16:19-21)

If I had to guess, I would say that most, if not all, Zionist Christians who are currently standing with Israel haven’t a clue where the promise of a new and renewed Covenant is found.

Sadly, it’s hard to understand the Scriptures and the prophecies if you don’t even know where you stand in the plan of Elohim.

The promise of a new and renewed Covenant was provided through the Prophet Jeremiah in chapters 30 through 31. I don’t have time or space to include it all in this message. Hopefully I can go into it further next week.

The reason for the renewed Covenant is because Yisrael broke the Covenant. If you read the text, you will notice that the parties are the two houses of Yisrael, not the Jewish people or the Christian Church.

Most people are familiar with the prophecy of the dry bones coming to life and the two sticks coming together as described in Ezekiel 37. The prophecy of this miraculous revival and uniting of the Kingdom of Yisrael concludes as follows:

“²¹ . . . Thus says Adonai YHWH: Behold, I will take the people of Yisrael from the Nations among which they have gone, and will gather them from all around, and bring them to their own land. ²² And I will make them one Nation in the Land, on the mountains of Yisrael. And one king shall be king over them all, and they shall be no longer two nations, and no longer divided into two kingdoms. ²³ They shall not defile themselves anymore with their idols and their detestable things, or with any of their transgressions. But I will save them from all the backslidings in which they have sinned, and will cleanse them; and they shall be my people, and I will be their Elohim. ²⁴ My servant David shall be king over them, and they shall all have one shepherd. They shall walk in My rules and be careful to obey My statutes. ²⁵ They shall dwell in the land that I gave to My servant Jacob, where your fathers lived. They and their children and their children’s children shall dwell there forever, and David My servant shall be their prince forever.” Ezekiel 37:21-25

This prophecy has not happened yet. It does not refer to the Jewish People and their religion that derived from the Pharisees. YHWH performs the miracle, and He places Yahushua as King over all the people in the Land.

The prophet Hosea confirms that the Servant David is at the center of the restoration, not David ben Gurion

“Afterward the children of Ysrael shall return and seek YHWH their Elohim, and David their king, and they shall come in fear to YHWH and to His goodness in the latter days.” Hosea 3:5

The return involves people seeking a repentant heart, not some Marxist Leninist Atheist Zionists who carry the banner of Saturn.

There is no discernable fear of YHWH in Israel, only the fear of Hamas. Those youth who were attacked at the rave party in front of a giant Buddha certainly didn't have any fear of YHWH. How about the ones who dance around a golden calf in the Dead Sea rave parties? Obviously not.

The problem is that their parents do not fear YHWH and likely never taught them the Ways of YHWH.

And that is the point of this message. Dwelling in the Land comes with great responsibilities. YHWH wants faithful stewards who will care for the Land and keep it “holy” – set apart.

Living in the Covenant Land as a Covenant people is conditional upon obedience, and a true Scriptural return requires repentance. At least that's what the Scriptures say.

“¹ Now it shall come to pass, when all these things come upon you, the blessing and the curse which I have set before you, and you call them to mind among all the Nations where YHWH your Elohim drives you, ² and you return to YHWH your Elohim and obey His voice, according to all that I command you today, you and your children, with all your heart and with all your soul, ³ that YHWH your Elohim will bring you back from captivity, and have compassion on you, and gather you again from all the nations where YHWH your Elohim has scattered you. ⁴ If any of you are driven out to the farthest parts under heaven, from there YHWH your Elohim will gather you, and from there He will bring you. ⁵ Then

YHWH your Elohim will bring you to the land which your fathers possessed, and you shall possess it. He will prosper you and multiply you more than your fathers. ⁶ And YHWH your Elohim will circumcise your heart and the heart of your descendants, to love YHWH your Elohim with all your heart and with all your soul, that you may live.”
Deuteronomy 30:1-6

These are all legal terms that Christian Zionists completely ignore. The question is whether people actually believe the Scriptures or if they just belong to a religion.

YHWH means what He says. If you want to live in the Land in Covenant with Him, you must love Him with all your heart and all your being . That’s the Shema.

Of course, you demonstrate your love for Him by obeying His Commands.

YHWH prophesied a great return that would overshadow and replace the Exodus from Egypt. (see Jeremiah 16:14-15) We are still talking about Egypt at Passover, so that promised return has clearly not occurred yet.

Yahushua was the promised seed. Christian Zionists should know and understand this.

Further, the return to the Land will involve Messiah Yahushua, not the Pharisees or a people who ignore or reject the Messiah. Again, Christian Zionists should know this. This is obvious if you actually read the Scriptures.

We have the benefit of hindsight. We know that Yahushua is the focus of the prophecies regarding Yisrael.

Why on Earth would so-called Christians take their focus off of Yahushua and focus on a group of people who were judged by Yahushua, generally reject the Messiah and then claim rights to the Land that belongs to YHWH?

Sadly, the Christian Zionist movement has turned the modern State of Israel and the Jewish people into an idol.

They now turn a blind eye to anything that the modern State of Israel does, regardless of how evil it may be. Well, whether or not they decide to take the blinders off, YHWH said He watches over the Land and He is watching over the Land now.

Ask yourself: “What exactly is He seeing in His face?”

I can tell you that He is seeing His Land be profaned by a fractured and divided people claiming to come from the ancient Yisraelites, but they function as a Parliamentary Democracy. The Torah is not the rule of the Land. They don't have a King, a Priesthood or a Temple. YHWH is not dwelling in their midst and they continue to reject the Son of Elohim, the rightful King, David His Servant.

They do not carry any of the hallmarks of a repentant, obedient, restored people functioning in a set apart priestly service to YHWH and the Nations. Instead, they display the Star of Saturn as their national banner.

Talmudic Judaism is not the faith of Yisrael and the modern State of Israel is Israel in name only. There is no Scriptural substance or fulfillment in the current Zionist State. They are simply occupying the Land that Yahushua will soon come and judge, cleanse and rule from.

YHWH currently sees before His face a nation that has hired marketing firms to “Brand Israel” and part of that branding involves becoming the LGBTQ capital of Europe, if not the world.

The word “brand” is the same as the word “mark.” The modern State of Israel has taken the mark of Babylon - the mark of the Beast.

I have mentioned many times the covenant of death that Israel made with Pfizer to become the “vaccination nation.”

I cannot write the unspeakable things that take place in Tel Aviv which has been called “Hollywood’s new billion-dollar Sin City.” It has been declared the gay capital of the world and the ultimate LGBTQ travel destination.

Benjamin Netanyahu has been an integral part of all of this and he is advocating the expansion LGBTQ activities to Jerusalem.

He can quote the Bible all he wants in order to garner the support of Christians and Orthodox Jews, but actions speak louder than words.

YHWH sees it all in His face, and it’s not good. The question is not whether He will bless those who bless Israel, but rather how long will He hold back His judgment upon Israel.

Sure, there are some people scattered around the Land who love and serve YHWH with all their hearts. They will be sealed and set apart by YHWH when His wrath is poured out on the Nations, including Israel. They may actually want to “come out of her” . . . lest they share in her in her sins, and lest they receive her plagues. (see Revelation 18:4)

Of course, America is no different and America has planted many of the seeds that are bearing bad fruit in Israel today. Israel is not alone,

they are simply the ones claiming a divine right to the Covenant Land. That is why the focus is presently on them.

The reason that I am spending so much time on this is because it impacts the message of the Messiah.

If Christians join their faith to a nation that does not believe in Yahushua then that presents a very troubling and confusing view of Elohim.

If every action of the modern state of Israel is “God ordained” because they are the chosen people, they will likely present YHWH in a terribly inaccurate light – just as they are doing now.

Followers of Yahushua are supposed to separate from darkness and shine the light of Yahushua, not exalt a group that collectively opposes Him and His message.

Remember that the Patriarch Joshua (Yahushua) brought the Yisraelites into the Land and apportioned the Land. That was a pattern for the future work of Yahushua the Messiah, according to Isaiah.

“Thus says YHWH: In a time of favor I have answered you; in a day of salvation (yashua) I have helped you; I will keep you and give you as a Covenant to the people, to establish the Land, to apportion the desolate heritages.” Isaiah 49:8

A time of favor is likely a Jubilee Year when YHWH restores Land rights and resolves title issues. We can expect Yahushua to come and turn the Day of YHWH into a Day of Salvation for Yisrael during a Jubilee. That is when He will apportion the Land to His people.

Until then, we must continue to spread light and life to a dark and dying world, and walk blameless in the face of YHWH.
