Note: Gematria in a very simple sense is the study of the various numerical values of the Hebrew letters and words. Since there is no separate numerical system in the Hebrew language, all Hebrew letters have a numerical value so it is a very legitimate and valuable form of study. There are many different forms of Gematria. The Gematria system used in this chart is mispar hechrachi, also known as Normative value. The Paleo font used is Paleo Ericology which is an attempt to blend the ancient variants into a uniform and recognizable font set that accurately depicts the original meaning of each character. It should be noted that this is not a historical font set, but simply an artists rendition of the ideal font. The Ancient font used is ToddPaleoFont and it is an accumulation of some of the oldest renderings of the Ancient Hebrew found through archaeology. It should be noted that there is no known "original" font set so the fonts used are attempts to show the original forms and meanings.
