The Egyptian visits allow you to walk the same paths as Moses and stand face-to-face with the same Pharaoh whom Moses addressed in the time of Exodus. You will be accompanied by a scholar who can tell you what it says. Not only will you see the Egyptian sites of the Exodus, but also those of Joseph. You will learn of the miraculous story of God's faithfulness to the Egyptian people by sending His servants, Abraham,

Jacob, Joseph, and Moses, to share in the unfolding of His glory. You will learn on this visit the importance and the documentation to which they responded and in which they believed. The evidence has always been there; yet, standard Egyptologists are not trained to speak about it. Next, you will receive a teaching on how the Proto-Hebraic language spread across the Red Sea via Joseph and his children, and where God formalized it in the Ten Commandments received by Moses. You will be witness to and see the earliest Hebrew languages directly in front of Mount Sinai in a cave that's hidden from view. Deuteronomy 6:6: "And these words which I command you today shall be in your heart. 7 You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up. 8 You shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. 9 You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates." With that, and more, it was the great Exodus!

#### **ITINERARY AT-A-GLANCE**

#### MAIN TOUR MARCH 30 - APRIL 9/10, 2026

March 30: Depart New York/JFK on Egypt Air at 12:55PM.

**March 31:** Arrive in Cairo 5:15AM. Rest, visit the Giza Plateau including the Pyramids (including entrance to one of the pyramids), the Sphinx, and the Dream Stele.

**April 1:** Egyptian Museum (original museum which includes artifacts of the Biblical Patriarchs), Land of Joseph, including Fayoum, Yoseph Canal, plus the mysterious Pillar of On.

**April 2:** Museum of Civilization (Mummies) and the Grand Egyptian Museum. Drive to Bitter Lakes/Suez Canal, overnight in Ismailia. Seder dinner.

**April 3:** Visit Avaris, the archaeology of Pi-Ramses and Tanis and its museums, the tomb of Shoshenq, and others. Unique ancient-style lunch of roasted lamb, herbs, and flatbread served under a tent. Return to Cairo for Shabbat.

**April 4:** Shabbat, airport hotel. 7:30PM, flight to Tabuk, Saudi Arabia. Overnight.

**April 5:** Early morning visit to Rephidim, Split Rock of Horeb with a tented lunch. Next, visit the site of the Nuweiba Red Sea crossing. Overnight at the Red Sea hotel.

**April 6:** Aynounah (Leuce), Midian: the Museum. Jethro's Tomb and Moses Well. Arrive Jabal al-Lawz. Cemetery of the Exodus and the Altar to the Golden Calf. Return to the Red Sea hotel.

**April 7:** Visit Moses' Altar, the archers' inscriptions, the Wilderness of Sinai, new sword or gouge inscriptions, and the cemetery. Optional overnight camp with dinner (or return to Red Sea hotel if you prefer not to camp).

**April 8:** Any climbers will climb this morning. The remainder of the guests relax or explore the newer Snake Rock inscriptions. Lunch at camp. 4:00PM, transfer to Jordan. Stop at Wadi Musa, the second place where a miracle of water coming from the rock took place. Overnight and dinner across from the entrance of Petra.

**April 9:** Breakfast at the hotel, early morning spectacular visit to Petra (ancient Sela) to visit the ancient tombs. Group lunch. Those flying home tonight say goodbye to those staying on. Drive the 3.5 hours straight to the Amman airport, to

arrive by 5:00PM. If taking the group air flight, it will depart at 8:10PM for Cairo. Overnight in Cairo at the Le Meridien Hotel at the airport.

**April 10:** Flight departs Cairo at 5:55AM, arrives in New York/JFK at 10:30AM.

#### OPTIONAL EXTENSION APRIL 9-13/14, 2026

**April 9:** Your group bids farewell this evening to those who are flying home. You have extra time today to walk to the high place of sacrifice at Petra and then enjoy a dinner, perhaps a Turkish bath, or just time in the scenic village. You will dine with your group this evening.

**April 10:** Following an early breakfast at the hotel, you will depart for a 7-hour trip via 4WD vehicles to En Mishpat (Kadesh) and past Aaron's Tomb and the ancient paths of Edom. You will feast on lamb on a barbecue for lunch, return to the hotel for Shabbat, and have dinner. (\*\*\*Note: today is the Feast of Unleavened Bread.)

**April 11:** A Shabbat breakfast and dinner at the hotel this evening.

**April 12:** Following breakfast, you will be driven to the area of Basra (Bozrah) by way of the longer, Desert Road. You will stop at the current archaeological site of Sodom and drive past the memorial to Lot's wife. Coming upon the entrance of the Arnon River, you will walk into the entrance of this river, which was one of the last camp sites of the Hebrews prior to the crossing of the Jordan River.

**April 13:** Today, you will visit Bethany Beyond the Jordan, which is Jesus' Baptismal site, and then on to Tell al Hammam (Shittim), Tel of Adam, Jabbock River (where Jacob met the Angel), and Deir Alla (Balaam Inscription). You will be at the Amman airport by 5:30PM for your 8:10PM departure on Egypt Air and then overnight at the Le Meridien Airport Hotel, located in the airport Terminal.

**April 14:** Flight departs Cairo at 5:55AM, arrives in New York/JFK at 10:30AM.

# April 1, Wednesday: Egyptian Museums, Joseph's Storehouses, and Archaeology


You will have breakfast at the hotel and then visit the Egyptian Museum, which will likely be your most intense and enthralling visit in all of Egypt. It has a wealth of Biblical antiquity and documentation that will prepare you for your next few days. You will have lunch nearby. This afternoon will likely prove to be one of your favorites: Fayoum. You may be one of today's only visitors to the storehouses that were built by Joseph and the small mysterious ancient pyramid. While here, you will walk amongst the massive storehouses of mud and straw brick, and you will be able to enter the ancient pyramid. Afterwards, you will take part in the discussion regarding the massive agricultural areas that were created by Joseph after Jehovah gave him the wisdom and knowledge of what Egypt was to face. You will learn that, in this location, Joseph first brought his father, Jacob, to see what miracles God had performed through Joseph's life, also visiting the canals that Joseph built. Lastly, you will be taken to a rarely-visited ancient site called the "Pillar of On." The mystery surrounding the messages contained on this pillar will be the highlight of your day. [BLD]

# April 2, Thursday: Mummies of the Bible, Suez Canal, Bitter Lakes, Passover Dinner

Today, you will be amazed at what has been preserved and found! The Museum of Civilization of Cairo, but, for us, the highlight is that you will come face-to-face with the mummy of every Pharaoh within the Exodus story and the story of Joseph. Lastly, today, you will visit Cairo's new gleaming beauty - the Grand Museum. Here, you will see the magnificent statues and the centuries of antiquity, quickly focusing on the aspects in this large museum that center on your Biblical interests. You will have an early lunch on the Nile River and then be driven outside the city to Ismalia, located near Lake Timsa on today's modern-day Suez Canal (Bitter Lakes in the Bible). You will overnight at a small French boutique hotel called the Maison Maxim de Lesseps, in the town of Ismailia. Personnel at this hotel witnessed the building and opening of the Suez Canal, and its quaint ambience is the perfect place for our Seder meal this evening. This will put you in closer proximity to Avaris in the morning. Of important note is that the city of Ismailia is where the Pharaoh Hophra slab was found. [BLD]

#### April 3, Friday: Goshen/Avaris

You will enjoy breakfast in the Ismalia hotel and then be driven two hours down the small, two-lane roads, which are often laden with donkey carts and tractors. You will arrive at the sites of Avaris and the massive outdoor museum site of Tanis. Your discussion with your fellow travelers will involve much of what archaeologist Manfred Bietek brought from fields that have now been planted over. These fields once hid the homes and archaeological sites of the Hebrews who resided here at the time of Moses. Pi-Ramses and the areas of the Hebrews were necessarily planted due to the agricultural requirements of the citizens of the Nile Delta and Egypt. Tanis is quite spectacular, considering that it is a true hodgepodge of found artifacts. Tanis is the Egyptian Pharaonic city known as ancient Zoan, and it is where Moses would first have approached Pharaoh about releasing the Hebrews. Tanis is also the location where the rare, silver mask of Shosheng was found, along with many other treasures. You will see this rare mask at the Egyptian Museum on March 31. Nearby, you will enjoy an authentic outdoor, barbequed lamb, flatbread, and herbs meal, along with your fellow travelers. After lunch, you will return to a hotel located onsite at the Cairo airport for Shabbat dinner and overnight. [BLD]

#### April 4, Saturday: Shabbat. Saudi Arabia

You will have breakfast at the hotel and then have a day of relative quiet, with lunch on your own. You will depart your hotel room today and prepare for your flight at 7:25PM, arriving in Tabuk at 9:25PM, then transferring to the hotel for dinner and overnight. [BD]

April 5, Sunday: Split Rock, Rephidim, Nuweiba Crossing Today, you will view an Egyptian boat inscription that will match an inscription found inside the Egyptian Museum. Adjacent, there is an ancient, anthropomorphic inscription of a being that is dated to be 5500 years old. Afterwards, you will join the Landcruisers and be off to your first MAJOR site on the Exodus route: the Split Rock of Horeb! You may climb and see the actual flow marks, walk around, and see the amazing inscriptions and some of the stone formations that were built either as tombs or as hunting tents. From here, you will be driven onto an overlook where you may envision Moses standing on one of

these hills, his arm upraised:

"And so it was, when Moses held up his hand, that Israel prevailed; and when he let down his hand, Amalek prevailed. 12 But Moses' hands became [a]heavy; so they took a stone and put it under him, and he sat on it. And Aaron and Hur supported his hands, one on one side, and the other on the other side; and his hands were steady until the going down of the sun. 13 So Joshua defeated Amalek and his people with the edge of the sword." Exodus 17:11-13

Yes, it happened here, and you may be able to pick up a perfectly-formed stone that was used in the battle against the Amalekites. You will have a picnic lunch and then, time permitting, you may see another new discovery, which is referred to as "Snake Rock" because it has snake inscriptions surrounding ancient Hebrew. You will spend the afternoon visiting the Nuweiba crossing site between Egypt and Saudi Arabia. Time and light permitting, you may have the rare opportunity to see a recently-discovered Midianite "high place" of sacrifice. You will spend the night on the Red Sea. [BLD]




#### April 6, Monday: Aynounah, Midian, Exodus Cemetery

Depending upon archeological access this morning, you will visit the site of Aynounah, or the place of Abraham's generations. This is the most ancient oasis in Arabia and is said to hold the remains of Abraham's descendants. Next, you're off to the Land of Midian, first visiting the Museum of Archaeology. At Al-Bid (in Midian), you will walk through the caves of Jethro—Moses' father-in-law—and visit the well site of Moses and Zipporah. Lunch today will take place on the Red Sea. Next is one of the most incredible sites near Mount Sinai, the Cemetery of the remains of the 3,000 souls killed by the Levites. And he said unto them,

"Thus saith the Lord God of Israel, Put every man his sword by his side, and go in and out from gate to gate throughout the camp, and slay every man his brother, and every man his companion, and every man his neighbor. And the children of Levi did according to the word of Moses: and there fell of the people that day about three thousand men." Exodus 32:27-28

You will see the standing stones and the grinding stones that belonged to the women who were put to death. The site has the tell-tale sign that it is a site of antiquity by order of the King. You will be returned to your Red Sea hotel for dinner and overnight. **[BLD]**



# April 7, Tuesday: Jabal Al-Lawz, Wilderness of Sinai, Moses Altar, Altar to the Golden Calf

Tonight is the optional night of camping, and it will be epic! You will arrive at Jabal al-Lawz, where you will visit the site where Moses descended the mountain and built the altar to Yahweh. Some scholars say that the white stone pillars, which are still there, represent the 12 Tribes of Israel. The guarry high above is the location from which the pillars were hewn; the Proto-Sinaitic inscriptions are unique to this location. You will dine tonight around a campfire beneath the looming, blackened top of Mount Sinai/Jabal al-Lawz. Today, you will also visit Aaron's Altar to the Golden Calf. Next, you will be driven into the Wilderness to stop and survey exactly where you are standing - in the Wilderness of Sinai with the magnificent, blackened mount before you and Rephidim behind you. Before arriving at your campsite, you will stop at the Altar to the Golden Calf that is also at a very curious site - right under the ominous, blackened top of Jabal al-Lawz and adjacent to even more curious inscriptions of worshiped Apis bulls with Egyptian characteristics and men and women impaled with long swords. The adventurous among your group will opt to overnight in this well-appointed, mobile camp, at which you will enjoy a BBQ dinner, while the remainder of the group will return to the resort hotel for another restful night at the Red Sea resort. # April 8, Wednesday: Sinai Climb, Amalekite Inscriptions, Sinai Desert, Aqaba

Those ascending Jabal al-Lawz will rise early. Depending upon one's climbing ability, destinations could include the Plateau of 70 Elders (5-6 hours round-trip), Elijah's Cave (6-7 hours), or the blackened summit (6-8 hours). Climbs will be completed in time for lunch, and then you will be driven via 4WD-Landcruisers to the alternate base side of Jabal al-Lawz and see the Amalekite Inscriptions of giants being shot with arrows. Time-permitting, you will see the newest sites that may be the stoves and molds needed for the Tabernacle, and then you will be driven through the Sinai Desert. The entire group returns to camp, where you will have your Saudifarewell camp lunch together with your amazing team. After some rest and great stories of intrigue, you will rejoin the 4WD vehicles and be driven north to the point where Saudi Arabia and Jordan meet, where you will cross over into Jordan and check into your hotel, which is directly in front of the entrance to Petra. You will have dinner at the hotel. [BLD]



April 9, Thursday: Petra (see optional Joshua extension)

You will have breakfast at your hotel and then walk into Petra. Today, you will be walking amongst the tombs of Petra, where the discussion will focus on the Hebrews who most likely spent 38 of their 40 years in and out of this hidden place of refuge. Your tour will end at the Christian section of Petra, and you will see where tombs were carefully converted into churches with baptismal. You will have a large lunch inside the basin of Petra and then say goodbye to your friends who are staying on to tour the areas of Joshua and the final steps of the Exodus through Jordan. Those of you flying out this evening will be driving 3 hours up to Amman after lunch. If you are taking the group air, your flight will depart at 8:10PM. You will have an overnight layover at the Cairo airport, where you can sleep in comfort at the Le Meridien airport hotel just steps from your arrival gate—and steps to your departure gate early tomorrow morning. A small meal is served on this flight; therefore, no meal is included this evening so that you can be in bed early. [BL]

#### April 10, Friday: Arrive New York/JFK

\*\*\*Note: The international check-in gate is a short, 15-minute walk from your hotel room. You should plan to be at the international check-in gate this morning, no later than 2:45AM for economy class and 3:30AM for business class, as your departure is at 5:55AM, nonstop to New York/JFK. You will arrive in New York/JFK at 10:30AM this morning; please do not schedule any onward flight until after 1:30PM, in case there are weather or luggage delays.

#### April 9, Saturday: Petra High Place, Mount Seir

You will return to the hotel this evening, where you can go next door and get a Turkish Bath, take a Jordanian cooking course, or walk around the quaint village of Sela (Petra). You will have dinner at the hotel. **[BLD]** 

#### April 10, Friday: En-mishpat (Kadesh Barnea)

You will have breakfast at your hotel and then be driven to En-mishpat (Kadesh Barnea) for the day, which is the land of the Edomites and numerous Old Testament stories involving Abraham, Isaac, and the Kings. You will be driven under and around the Mount of Nabi il Harun, or the tomb of Aaron, and then enjoy a fresh lamb barbecue. During this day, you will have almost completely circumnavigated very important areas of the Old Testament times with Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, Hagar, and those Kings who warred with the Patriarchs. You will return to the hotel for dinner. **[BLD]** 

#### April 11, Saturday: Shabbat

# April 13, Monday: Bethany Beyond the Jordan, Tel of Adam, Shittim, Jabbock River

Today, you will visit Bethany Beyond the Jordan, Tell al Hammam—which has one of the longest-running ancient archaeological tells—and the adjacent field of Shittim, where the Tabernacle was set up and the Hebrews were laid out in full display when Balaam was asked to curse them. You will continue on to see the Tel of Adam (from a distance of about ½-mile), which is currently a military site, then the Jabbock River where Jacob wrestled with the angel and where his name was changed to Israel. Time-permitting, you will climb the Tell of Deir Alla, where the Balaam inscription was located. You will stop for a hearty farewell lunch, and then you will be at the Amman airport this evening for your 8:10PM departure on Egypt Air. You will arrive in Cairo at 8:35PM, where you will be met and transferred back to your airport hotel, the Movenpick. The additional cost of this hotel is included in the air add-on. If you choose to fly home from Amman on a different airline or plan, you may need an extra night in a hotel tonight. No dinner is included this evening, as you will have such a short night of sleep. Egypt Air will deliver a quick sandwich on our 1-hour flight from Amman to Cairo, and you may order room service, if you like, at the Movenpick for your short night. [BL]



#### PROPER DOCUMENTATION

All members of this tour must carry passports that are valid for at least six months beyond their scheduled date of return (October 17, 2026). A visa will be required for Saudi Arabia; a link will be sent to you. It is very easy to complete the form. At the present time, the fee is \$80 USD. All visitors to Egypt will purchase a visa for \$20 USD upon arrival. Visas for Jordan are included. No vaccinations are required. However, please note that things may also change. Please note that the vendors will have already accepted your booking, knowing that there is a current global threat. Therefore, if you book this tour, you are accepting the terms of the airlines, the TSA, the countries to which you are traveling, and/ or other governing parties without fully knowing what they will be by the time that you actually travel.

#### **AIR TICKETS**

You are welcome to book any air schedule you prefer. We do offer a recommended round-trip air schedule on Egypt Air from New York/JFK. They offer an economy class price or a business class price. Egypt Air is a United Airlines partner. If you wish to arrange your own air schedule and you would like us to include airport arrival and departure transfers, please arrive and depart on our flights, or prior to our flight's arrival (or after our departure). #### LIMITATIONS

Destinations and the sites offered here can be withdrawn at any time due to government restrictions and other reasons beyond our control. Cancellations attributed to Covid or to any new disease-related creations and acts of war, postponements, and such of any kind are not the responsibility of LP. You are booking the trip at your own risk, and penalties will not be waived.
